# One World Dialogue with students from Cameroon and Germany

## Idea

In an internet-based video call, young students from a secondary school in Cameroon and from a secondary school in Germany will get in contact with each other and discuss about topics on equality, sustainability and peace. By doing this, both sides will have the chance to identify differences and equivalences between their countries, but also difficulties and strengths of the societies they are living in.

## Format

A video call will be organized, e.g. via Zoom or Skype with computers and projector as equipment, between a classes/groups of 15-30 participants, each one based at a secondary school in Cameroon and Germany. The call will be in English only. The students shall be not younger than 15 years. One video call might last 1.5 to 2.5 hours.

### Preparation

The format shall be organized by one person responsible at each school. Communication, funding and coordination can be provided by the German Earth Charter office in collaboration with a coordination team in Cameroon.

Before the video call there should be at least one lesson to introduce the Earth Charter and the topics of exchange (e.g. equality, sustainability, peace) with the students at each school. The Cameroonian Earth Charter group can provide assistance and input.
